

Hello Future Bethune Students and Parents/Guardians,

Unfortunately, Bethune will not be offering the 2 week Bear Camp in July as we have done in the past; however, we are excited to offer a different opportunity for our incoming grade 9 students,

Incoming grade 9's have an opportunity to complete a FULL CREDIT REACH AHEAD course during the month of July at Bethune: BTT1O1.

BTT1O1 (Information and Communication Technology in Business) is a grade 9 credit course that covers digital literacy, word processing, spreadsheets, databases and web development. This course is also available during the school year.

Summer school at Bethune is an excellent opportunity to get to know some Bethune staff and students and become familiar with the school and all our programs before you begin grade 9 in September. We are also offering select courses in grade 10, 11 and 12.

Registration will **open at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 19** and students will be registered on a first come, first served basis.

Students who have chosen BTT1O1 through MyBlueprint and wish to complete it in the summer instead will need to choose another optional course. This can be done through the sign up link.

Summer School runs from July 2 to July 26 from 8:45 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and students are required to attend for the full 19 days. Students who are absent for 2 or more days may be demitted from the course.

Students will receive notification of admission to summer school by March 25 via email.

This opportunity is available only for students who have pre-registered to attend Bethune in September for grade 9.
