

SPECIAL COMMENCEMENT AWARDS FOR GRADUATING STUDENTS

Graduating students who think they may be eligible for any of the commencement awards listed below should **pick up an application form today** from the Guidance office.

1. **THE BETHUNE 25th ANNIVERSARY SCHOLARSHIP AWARD** is presented by both former and current staff and graduates. The recipient of this award best exemplifies the well-rounded student. They have been a positive role model for their peers, maintained a solid academic average and have been involved in extra curricular activities throughout the school.
2. **THE DR. BRENDA SHAPIRO MEMORIAL AWARD** is presented by the Bethune staff and students in memory of Brenda Shapiro who was the first Science Department Head of Bethune from 1979-1987. This award is given to the graduating student who best typifies the personality and values of the late Dr. Shapiro in displaying a friendly zest for living and being involved in a wide range of school activities.
3. **THE DR. NORMAN BETHUNE C.I. STAFF SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS** are presented to two graduating students who best exemplify the qualities of scholarship, leadership and participation in school activities and who are going on to post-secondary education. The recipients are chosen by the staff.
4. **THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR'S AWARD** is presented for exemplary student involvement in the community.
5. **THE PRINCIPAL'S AWARD FOR STUDENT LEADERSHIP** is presented to the graduating student who has demonstrated exceptional leadership in all aspects of school life.
